



How to get your **Connecticut Broker License**



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the [Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection](#) website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above

Step 2: You must successfully complete the required 60-hour [pre-licensing course](#) in Real Estate Principles and Practices at an institution approved by the Connecticut Department of Consumer protection.

Step 3: You must complete a 15-hour classroom course in Real Estate Brokerage Principles and Practices.

Step 4: You must complete a 15-hour classroom course in Legal Compliance.

Step 5: You must complete two 15-hour pre-license elective courses, OR one 30-hour pre-license appraisal course, OR provide evidence that you successfully completed at least 20 real estate transactions in the previous 5 years.

Step 6: You must be actively engaged for at least two years as a licensed real estate salesperson under the supervision of a real estate broker in this state.

Step 7: You must submit your [application](#) for a Connecticut Real Estate Broker License. Be sure to follow the application procedures required by the state's licensing department.

Step 8: You must pass the Connecticut Salesperson licensing examination earning a score of 70% or higher.
