



How to get your **Virginia Real Estate License**



Step 1: Meet Virginia real estate license requirements as outlined by the <u>Virginia Department</u> of Professional and Occupational Regulation Real Estate Board.

They include:

- You must be 18 years and above.
- You must Have a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- **Step 2:** Successfully complete the required 60-hour <u>pre-licensing course</u> for salesperson at an institution approved by the Virginia Real Estate Board.
- **Step 3:** Register and pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 70% or higher.
- **Step 4:** You must submit your fingerprints for a <u>criminal background check</u>.
- **Step 5:** Pass the State and National portion of exam.
- **Step 6:** Submit your <u>application</u> for a Virginia real estate license. Be sure to follow the application procedures required by Real Estate Board.
- **Step 7:** Complete 30 hours of <u>post-license education</u>.
