



How to get your Arizona Real Estate License



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the [Arizona Department of Real Estate website](#).

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above
- You must be a truthful, honest, worthy in character and competent applicant.
- You must not have been convicted of a felony, or convicted of a misdemeanor offense, such as (but not limited to) theft, forgery, extortion, conspiracy to defraud, violence against another person, or crimes of moral turpitude
- You must not have had a real estate license denied within one year, or revoked within two years immediately preceding the application.

Step 2: Complete the required 90-hour [pre-licensing course](#) for salesperson at an institution approved by the Arizona Department of Real Estate.

Step 3: Submit an [application](#) for an Arizona real estate license exam and schedule your exam.

Step 4: Pass the Arizona Salesperson licensing exam by earning a score of 75% or higher.

Step 5: You must submit your fingerprints and pass a [criminal background check](#).

Step 6: You must attend and pass a 6-hour Contract Writing Class.

Step 7: Submit your application for an Arizona real estate license.
