



How to get your Kentucky Real Estate License



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the [Kentucky Real Estate Commission](#) website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above
- You must have a high school diploma or its equivalent.

Step 2: Complete the required 96-hour [pre-licensing course](#) or complete 6 credit hours of real estate course for salesperson at an institution approved by the Kentucky Real Estate Commission.

Step 3: Register and pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 75% or higher.

Step 4: You must obtain and provide proof of Error & Omission Insurance.

Step 5: Submit your application for a Kentucky real estate license. Be sure to follow the application procedures required by KREC.

Step 6: Complete the required 48 hours of [post-license courses](#).
