



How to get your

Kentucky Real Estate License



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the <u>Kentucky Real Estate</u> <u>Commission</u> website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above
- · You must have a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- **Step 2:** Complete the required 96-hour <u>pre-licensing course</u> or complete 6 credit hours of real estate course for salesperson at an institution approved by the Kentucky Real Estate Commission.
- **Step 3:** Register and pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 75% or higher.
- Step 4: You must obtain and provide proof of Error & Omission Insurance.
- **Step 5:** Submit your application for a Kentucky real estate license. Be sure to follow the application procedures required by KREC.
- **Step 6:** Complete the required 48 hours of <u>post-license courses</u>.
