



How to get your

Louisiana Real Estate License



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the <u>Louisiana Real Estate Commission</u> website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above
- · You must have a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- **Step 2:** You must successfully complete the required 90-hour <u>pre-licensing course</u> for salesperson at an institution approved by the Louisiana Real Estate Commission.
- **Step 3:** Submit your <u>application Part A</u> for a Louisiana real estate license. Be sure to follow the application procedures required by LREC.
- **Step 4:** Register and pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 75% or higher.
- **Step 5:** You must pass a criminal background check.
- **Step 6:** You must obtain and provide proof of Error & Omission Insurance. For more information visit <u>LREC</u>.
- **Step 7:** Submit your <u>application Part B</u> for a Louisiana real estate license. Be sure to follow the application procedures required by LREC.
- **Step 8:** Obtain a <u>sponsoring broker</u>. Are you curious about <u>how to choose the right broker for you?</u>
- **Step 9:** Complete 45 hours of post-licensing education.
