



How to get your Missouri Real Estate License



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the [Missouri Real Estate Commission](#) website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above.
- You must have a high school diploma or its equivalent.

Step 2: Complete the required 48-hour [pre-licensing course](#) for salesperson at an institution approved by the Missouri Real Estate Commission.

Step 3: You must submit your fingerprints and pass a [criminal background check](#) through the IDEMIA.

Step 4: Complete [application for licensure](#) within six months from the date of completion of the 48-Hour pre-exam course.

Step 5: Pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 70% or higher in the national portion and 75% or higher in the state portion.

Step 6: Provide a certificate of completion for the 24-hour Missouri Real Estate Practice Course prior to submitting an [application for licensure](#).
