



How to get your

Missouri Real Estate License



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the <u>Missouri Real Estate</u> <u>Commission</u> website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above.
- · You must have a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- **Step 2:** Complete the required 48-hour <u>pre-licensing course</u> for salesperson at an institution approved by the Missouri Real Estate Commission.
- **Step 3:** You must submit your fingerprints and pass a <u>criminal background check</u> through the IDEMIA.
- **Step 4:** Complete <u>application for licensure</u> within six months from the date of completion of the 48-Hour pre-exam course.
- **Step 5:** Pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 70% or higher in the national portion and 75% or higher in the state portion.
- **Step 6:** Provide a certificate of completion for the 24-hour Missouri Real Estate Practice Course prior to submitting an <u>application for licensure</u>.
