



# How to get your New Jersey Real Estate License



**Step 1:** Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the [New Jersey Real Estate Commission](#) website.

**They include:**

- You must be 18 years old and above.
- You must have a high school diploma or its equivalent.
- You must Possess good character, trustworthiness, honesty, and integrity.

**Step 2:** Complete the required 75-hour [pre-licensing course](#) at an institution approved by the New Jersey Real Estate Commission.

**Step 3:** Register and pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 70% or higher.

**Step 4:** You submit your fingerprints and pass a [criminal background check](#).

**Step 5:** Obtain a sponsoring broker. Are you curious about [how to choose the right broker for you?](#)
