

Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the <u>New Mexico Real Estate</u> <u>Commission</u> website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above
- You must be a legal resident of United States
- **Step 2:** Complete the required 90-hour <u>pre-licensing course</u> at an institution approved by the New Mexico Real Estate Commission.
- **Step 3:** <u>Register</u> and pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 75% or higher.
- **Step 4:** You must obtain and provide proof of Error & Omission Insurance.
- **Step 5:** You must submit your fingerprints and pass a criminal background check.
- **Step 6:** Submit your application for a New Mexico real estate Associate Broker license. Be sure to follow the application procedures required by NMREC.

Note: Before you can be fingerprinted, you must first register on the state vendor website Gemalto. After registering on <u>Gemalto</u>, you will need to <u>contact</u> <u>Cogent ID</u> for Live Scan locations.
