



How to get your Ohio Real Estate License



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the [Ohio Real Estate Commission](#) website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above
- You must have a high school diploma or its equivalent
- Be honest, truthful and of good reputation
- Not have been convicted of a felony or a crime of moral turpitude

Step 2: Complete the required 120-hour [pre-licensing course](#) at an institution approved by the Ohio Real Estate Commission.

Step 3: [Register](#) and pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 70% or higher.

Step 4: You must pass a [criminal background check](#).

Step 5: Obtain a sponsoring broker. Are you curious about [how to choose the right broker for you?](#)

Step 6: Submit your application for an Ohio real estate license. Be sure to follow the application procedures required by OREC.

Step 7: Complete 20 hours of [post-licensing education](#).

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
