



How to get your

Pennsylvania Real Estate License



Step 1: Meet the state's requirements as outlined on the <u>Pennsylvania Real Estate</u> Commission website.

They include:

- You must be 18 years old and above
- · You must have a high school diploma or its equivalent
- · You must be a legal U.S resident

You must successfully complete the required 75-hour <u>pre-licensing course</u> at an institution approved by the Pennsylvania Real Estate Commission.

Register and pass the licensing exam by earning a score of 70% or higher.

Step 3:

You must pass a criminal background check.

Submit your <u>application</u> for a Pennsylvania real estate license. Be sure to follow
